This year we are working towards achieving the Silver Level Reading Award from the Scottish Book Trust. One of our biggest goals at St. Vincent's is to inspire a love of reading and broaden our children's vocabulary.

For World Book Day 2023 (Thursday 2nd March) we are asking your child to come to school dressed as a wow word. Your child should learn the definition of the word and throughout the day we will try to guess the word they have come as. This means that by the end of the day every child will have learnt lots of new and exciting words and will have great fun too!

Some examples are:

Wear the same clothes as your friend and come as *identical*

Stick Monopoly money to your outfit and come as affluent
